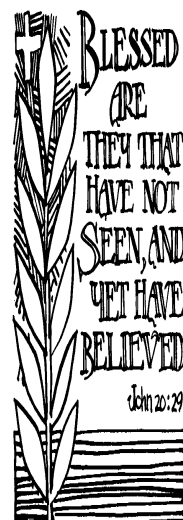

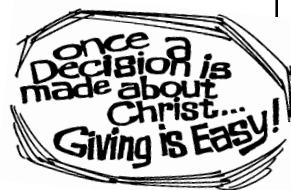
PAKISTAN FLOODING CONTINUES :
