Contributing to this renovation was the purpose of our Lenten Appeal during 2010.

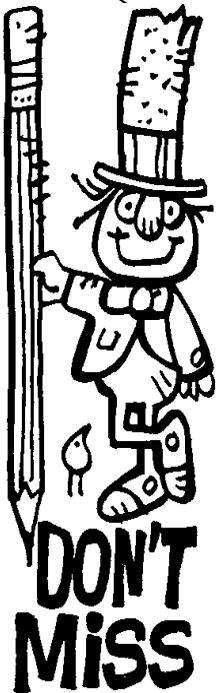
COLE VOUCHERS :

CHRISTMAS ART WORK IN THE CHURCH:

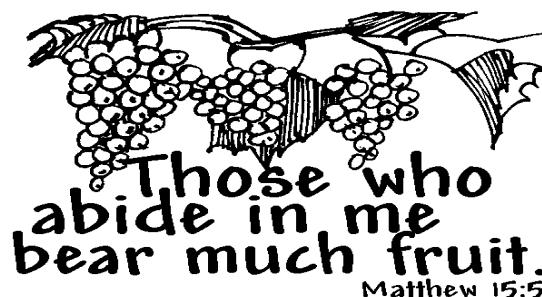
Given the strong emphasis on the family that is part of our Christmas celebrations, we would like to have art work in the Church that associates our parish families with the Holy Family.

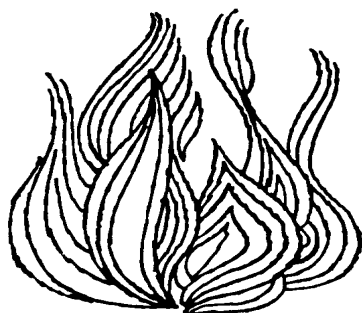
