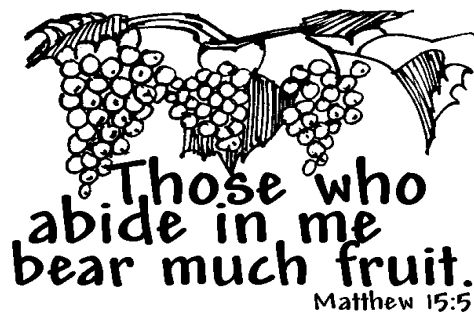
### **COFFEE SALES :**
