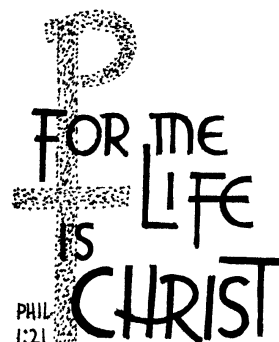

Members of the Social Justice Group will be selling East Timor coffee at all Masses this weekend.

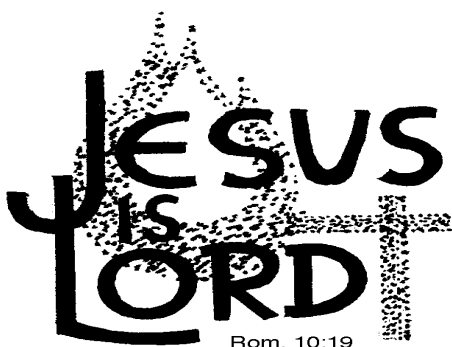
The coffee is produced in East Timor and all proceeds go to our twin parish in Remexio.
