**FEET FOR HOLY THURSDAY :**

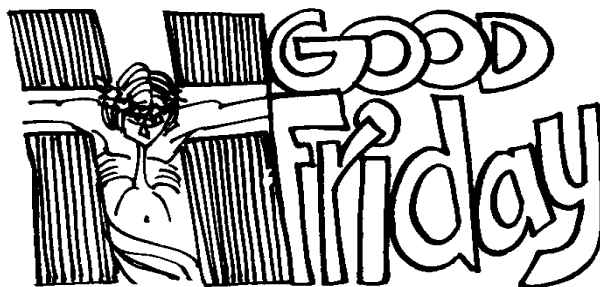
We have only two sets of feet for the Washing of the Feet on Holy Thursday. *Please volunteer !!!*
