FORMATION IN FAITH : "Understanding the Scriptures"

There will be three talks by Fr Frank on Understanding the Scriptures. These talks will look into the way the Scriptures come to be, the ways of interpreting them and using them as a guide for our lives.

'That's a nice story, but now tell me where you've really been for the last 3 days.'

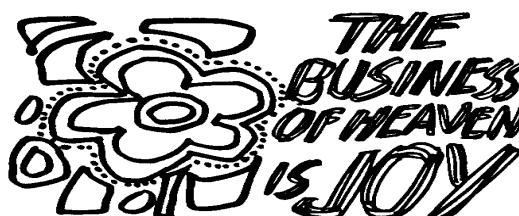
Michelangelo's mum :
