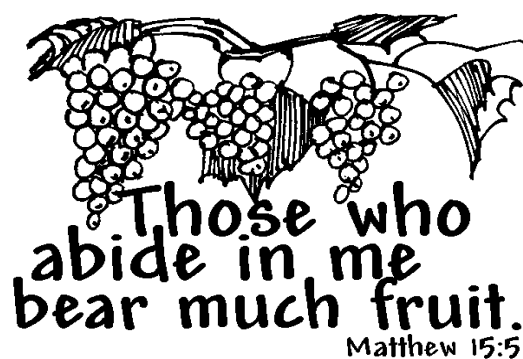

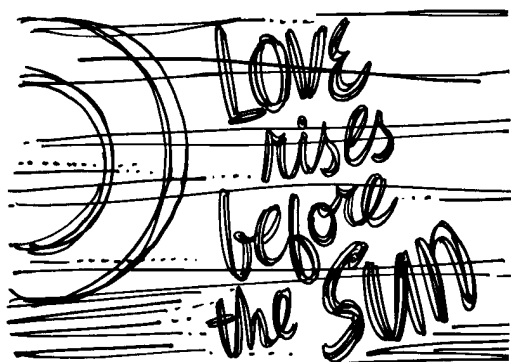
There will be a leaving collection. Envelopes will be on the Church benches. *Thank you*
