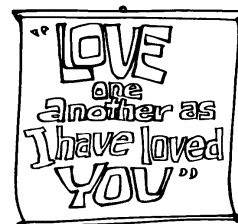

There will be a leaving collection. Envelopes are on the Church benches. *Thank you*

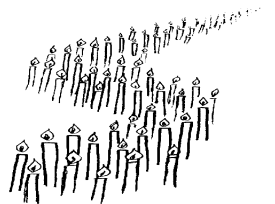
Catholic Care deals with the needs of families and individuals who are in need of counselling and help to get their lives back on track.

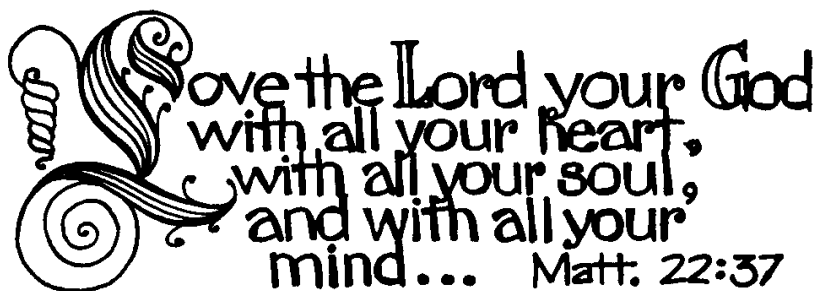
