NEW BAPTISMAL PROCEDURE :

There will be a new procedure for those parents seeking the baptism of their children from February next year. It will be as follows :

- A visit from Fr Frank to the family
- A 'Welcoming of the Child into the Church' at Sunday Mass on the 1st Sunday of each month. (This is a simple ceremony of a few minutes duration but it helps to make the point that a core element of baptism is joining the Church)
