## **CATECHUMENATE for CATHOLICS :**

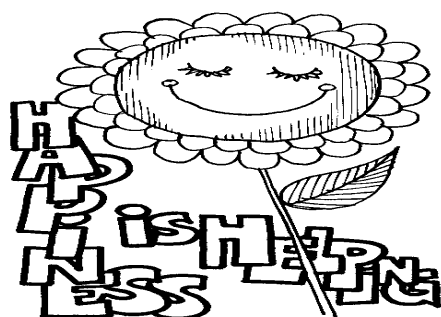
