



MARY MACKILLOP HERITAGE CENTRE is celebrating the Feast Day of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop on Wednesday August 8th.


The Sisters of St Joseph invite you to visit the Mary MacKillop Heritage Centre on **Saturday August 4th from 10am to 4pm**.
