

The No Interest Loan Scheme (NILS) provides interest-free loans for individuals or families on a low income.

NILS is a community-based program that enables people to access fair, safe and equitable credit for the purchase of essential goods and services.

NILS is generally used for the purchase of household items like fridges, washing machines, TVs and furniture and other essential needs like health aids, education costs (computers, books, etc, not fees).

NILS cannot be used for emergency relief, bond or rent money, living expenses or debt repayment.
