

REMEXIO CHRISTMAS APPEAL

Last weekend we launched the annual Christmas Appeal for the families in our twin parish in Remexio, East Timor. Father David, the parish priest of Remexio, recently visited Sandringham and spoke at Masses last weekend.

His commitment to improving the lives of those in his community, especially the poorest people, was obvious. Fr David spoke of the reality of poverty in East Timor and inspired many of us to do what we can to improve the lives of our nearest neighbours.

As the Christmas season approaches, we have the opportunity to make this feast an even happier occasion for those in our twin parish.

As happened last year, fliers and envelopes will be distributed to school families and will be available after Masses this week.
