NEW PARISH LEADERSHIP COUNCIL: Over the last couple of months with discussion at the last few Pastoral Council meetings, it has been decided to change the structure of the Parish Pastoral Council a little.

HAVE

The main change is that there will be members of other committees on the Leadership Council eg, from the Finance Committee, from the Building, Maintenance & Art Committee.

There will be two members from the various ministries in the parish (on a rotating basis) and two elected members. For the moment the elected members will be those parishioners last elected to the Parish Council. So the New Leadership Council will be comprised of Norman Griffiths (Chairman); Erin Macdonald (School Principal); John Noonan (Building, Art & Maintenance); Adrian Power (Administration & Finance); Megan McCartney and Phil Gomez (Ministries) and Jane Standish and Kristen Allen (Elected) and Fr Frank.

SUNDAY FOR THE SICK: August 8th & 9th: Each year we have a Sunday on which we celebrate the Anointing of the Sick during our Sunday Masses for those among us who are ill or frail. Families are welcome to bring family members or friends along. Residents from the local hostels for the Aged and Nursing Homes are very welcome of course. Anointing will be celebrated at all three Masses and there will be a cuppa in the foyer after the 9am and 11am Masses.

People to be anointed need to be seated in accessible places in the Church. There will be parishioners on hand to help with this.

MASS FOR DERRUM KEARNS: Derrum was a teacher here at Sacred Heart some years ago. He died just recently in Adelaide. We will be having a Mass for him this coming *Wednesday, July 29th at <u>8.30am</u>*. This earlier time is to enable teachers who knew Derrum to attend Mass without disrupting the school hours too much.
