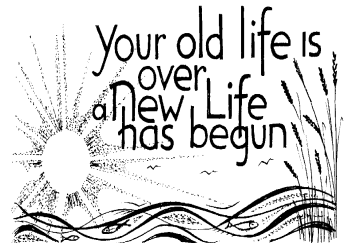

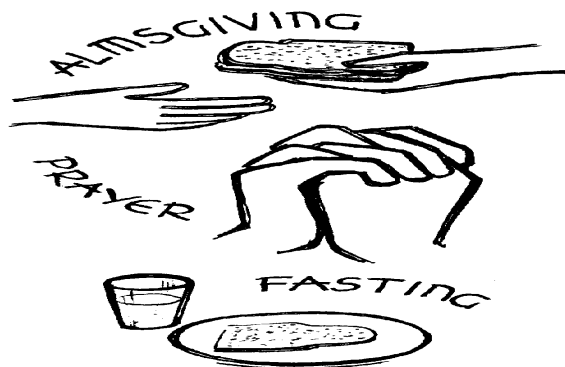

TODAY and next week Fr Frank will be looking for **FEET to WASH**

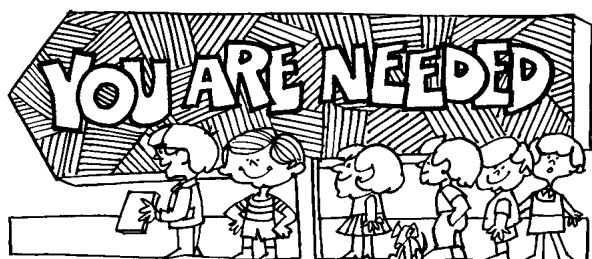
MINISTRIES for HOLY WEEK :
