## **SACRIFICIAL OFFERING RENEWAL:**

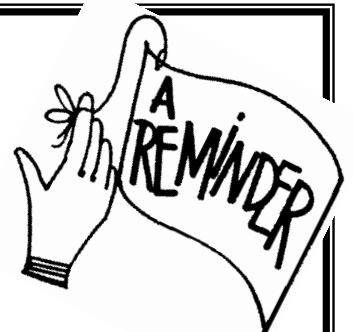

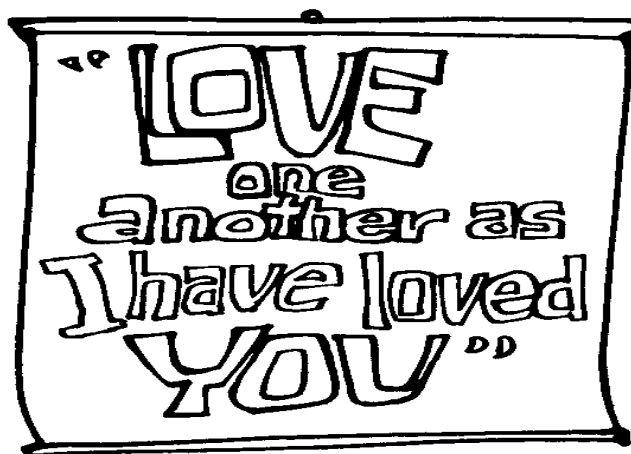
