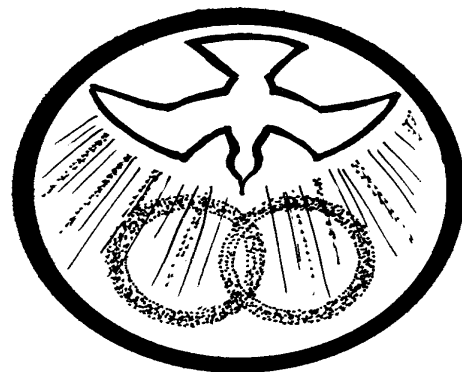

SUNDAY FOR THE SICK: Each year we have a Sunday on which those who are ill or frail are offered the opportunity to be anointed and prayed for at our Sunday Masses. This year this will take place on Sunday May 25th at each Mass.

CONSECRATION OF THE CHURCH:

On the feast of the Sacred Heart, June 27th, we will continue our Centenary Celebrations by consecrating our Parish Church. Churches are blessed when they are first opened, but they were rarely consecrated because they had to be paid for before they could be consecrated—just in case they were re-possessioned!

This has now changed, but it explains the gap in time between erecting and opening a Church and consecrating it.

The Archbishop will come to consecrate the Church and the altar. It is a quite dramatic liturgy with a fire being lit on the altar for one notable thing. And 12 crosses with attached candlesticks will be placed permanently around the walls of the Church.

Over the next weeks, there will be a segment in our Notice Sheet which will explain more about the consecration of a Church.

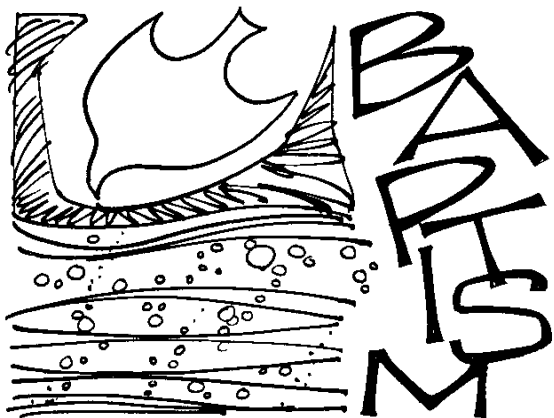
