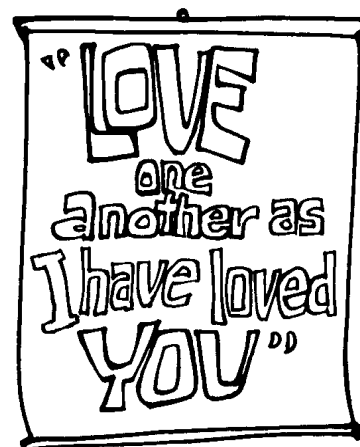

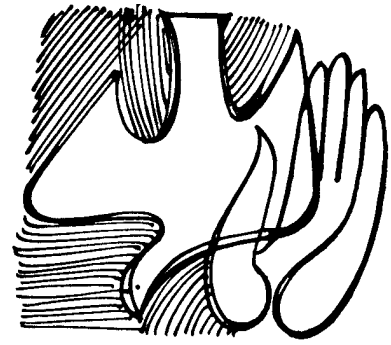

### **DEDICATION OF THE CHURCH - PART 4 - 27th June 2014**

The celebration of the Dedication of the Church begins after the Entrance Hymn and Greeting, with the Archbishop blessing Holy Water and then sprinkling the people and the walls of the Church with this Holy Water. Then followed by the Opening Prayer.

There are then 3 readings from the Scripture with a homily from the Archbishop. There then follows the Dedication of the Altar and the Church which involves the altar and walls of the Church being anointed and incensed and then the candles on the altar and the 12 candles around the walls are lit.

Then follows the celebration of the Eucharist. It is a very symbolic and colourful celebration about which there will be more details over the weeks to come.
