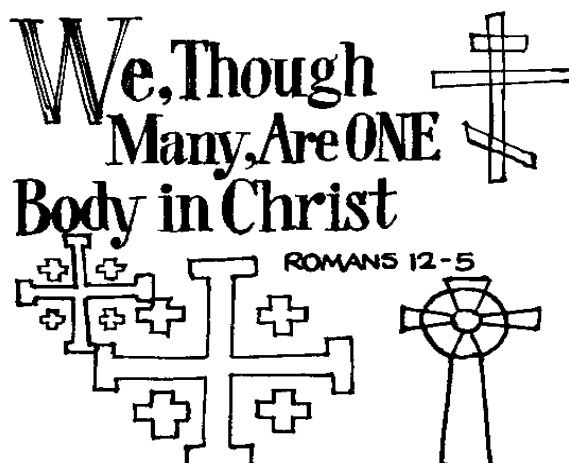
**FORMATION IN FAITH FOR MOTHERS:** Continues this Tuesday June 24th at 7.45pm in the foyer of the Church
