## **AN UPDATE ON REFUGEES AND ASYLUM SEEKERS**

There was better news for some families in detention this week with the government decision to release children under ten years of age, and their families, into community detention on bridging visas.

We applaud this decision, which will involve approximately 150 children who arrived in Australia before 19 July 2013 and who are in detention in Australia.

However, questions remain:

- ◊ What about the other 290 children detained in mainland Australia?
- ◊ What about the 331 children detained offshore, on Christmas Island and Nauru?
- ◊ Why are children who arrived on 18 July treated differently to those who arrived later?
- ◊ Why are 11, 12, 13 year olds treated differently to 10 year olds?
- ◊ Why are those held offshore treated differently to those detained in Australia?

Have a conversation with your friends and family about the injustice of this situation.

Put pressure on the government to extend the release to all children in detention (contact our local member, Andrew Robb).

Join ***Grandmothers Against Detention of Refugee Children*** on the steps of St Paul's Cathedral on **Saturday 6 September at 2pm** (wear a purple scarf).

Children suffer serious trauma in detention irrespective of when they arrived in Australia and none should continue to be locked up, either in Australia or offshore.
