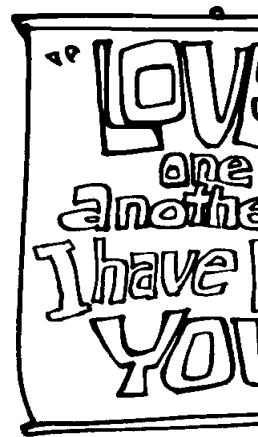

the civil war ended in 2009 with the killing of an estimated 100,000 people. Despite the end of the war, there is continuing torture and persecution of Tamil people, some of whom have come to Australia seeking asylum. The government's response has been to send one group back to Sri Lanka and hold another group for a month on a customs ship before sending them to Nauru. There are also 40 Tamils in detention because of UNHCR and SIO reports. They have been held for six years, with no end in sight and no limit on how long they can be held.

Can our government claim it is acting justly towards these people fleeing violence and persecution?
