FEAST OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

When the dates of certain feasts fall on a Sunday they take precedence over the Sunday liturgy. This usually involves an important feast of Our Lord or Our Lady. The particular feast this Sunday may puzzle you! The Lateran Basilica is the Cathedral of Rome — St John Lateran (not St Peter's). This was the original residence of the Bishop of Rome, that is, the Pope. It was the first great Basilica built in Rome under the patronage of the first Christian Roman Emperor Constantine. It was built, or at least begun, in the 4th century. It is because it is the Cathedral of Rome that the feast of its dedication is given such standing.

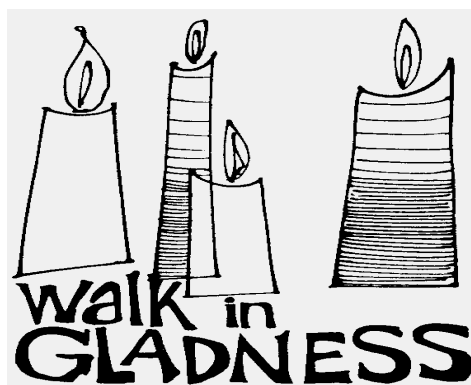
