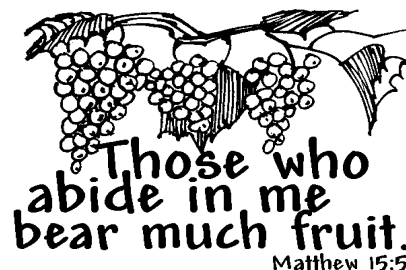

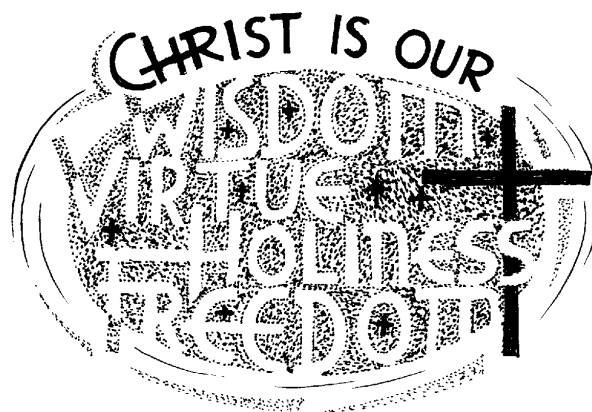

Then to Dublin where I visited Glendalough, the monastery founded by St Kevin in the 6th century, and fell in love with it. Then on to London and home.

**NEW ASSISTANT BISHOPS FOR MELBOURNE:** Two new assistant bishops have been appointed for the Archdiocese of Melbourne: Bishop Terry Curtin and Bishop Mark Edwards. Bishop Curtin teaches at Catholic Theological College and was parish priest of Greythorn. Bishop Edwards was an Oblate priest (O.M.I); he has been a principal of schools and was Novice Master for the Oblates of Mary Immaculate in Australia.
