The second of our sessions on Scripture will take place Tuesday 17th March at 7.30pm in the Old Parish Hall

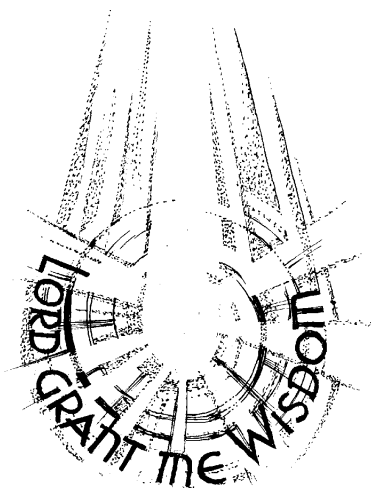
The talk will be given by Fr Frank.
