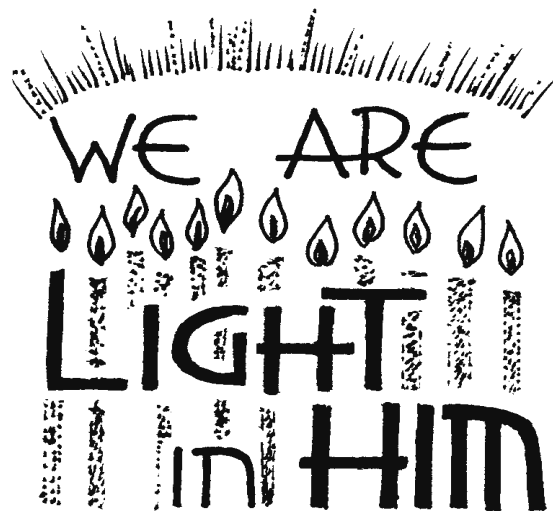
ADVENT begins on Sunday November 29th.
