Please see Fr Frank after Mass to add your name to the list.

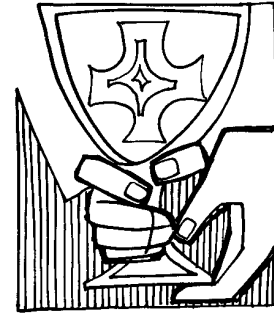
