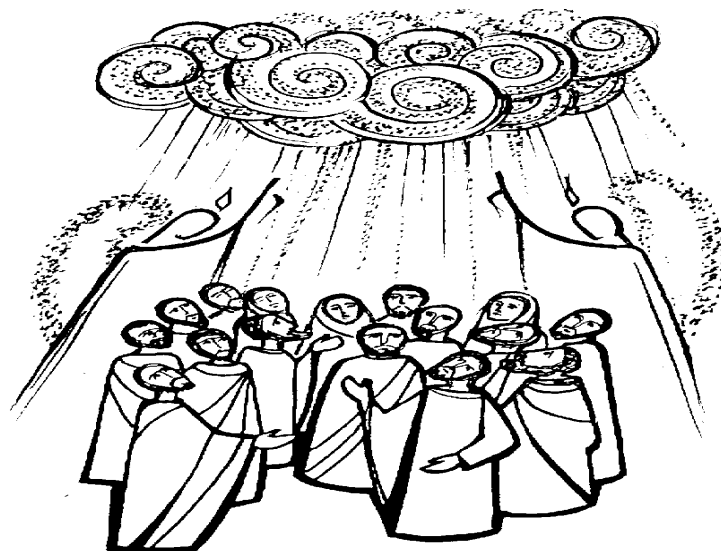

Our next get-together will be this Sunday May 8, 4pm at

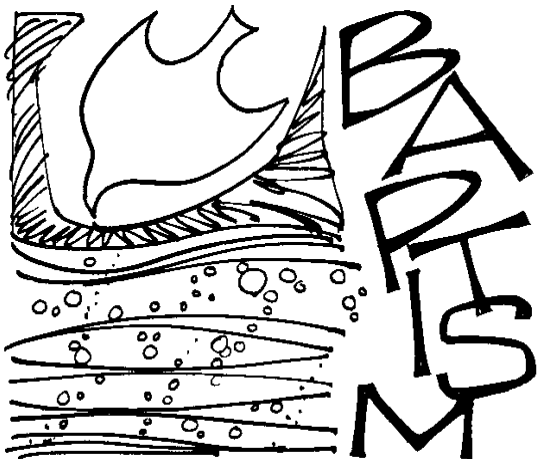
