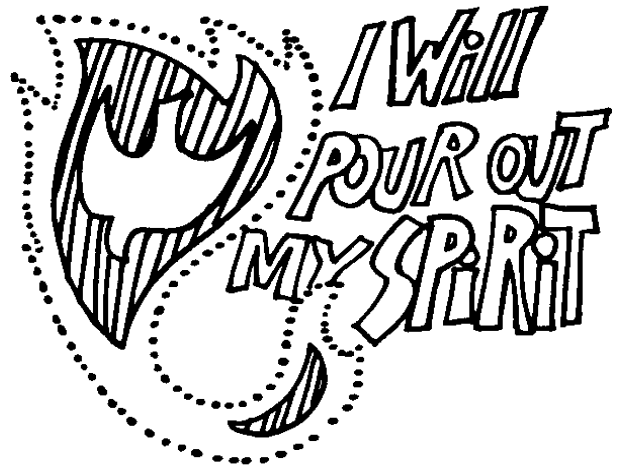

BECOMING A CATHOLIC!

Every year there is a group of adults who want to find out about becoming a Catholic and most, after their initial enquiry, go on to complete the process involved which is called the 'Catechumenate'.

It has been encouraging that every year (with one exception) people have come forward wanting to become Catholics.

The process involved takes a bit over twelve months with fortnightly meetings which culminate at Easter with the candidates either being baptized or received into the Church if they have already been baptised. This takes time precisely because it is an adult journey.

Those wishing to become Catholics are accompanied on your journey of faith by six parishioners who come along to all the meetings and take part in them. If anyone wanted to enquire about this, they could ring Fr Frank on 9598 1511.

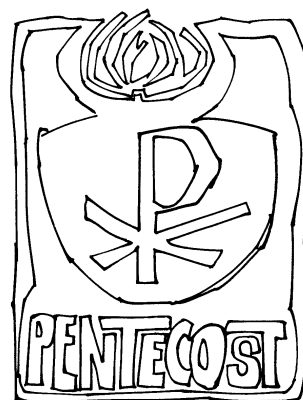
