So there is no need to be part of the roster, but if you know what to do, we can call on you when you are at Mass.

2. Writers of the Prayers of the Faithful. Various parishioners write the intentions of the Prayers of the Faithful each Week. There are 4 or 5 people doing this. We would like a few more people involved in this ministry. People are provided with the readings of the Sunday and they will be provided with models to follow as they begin the ministry.

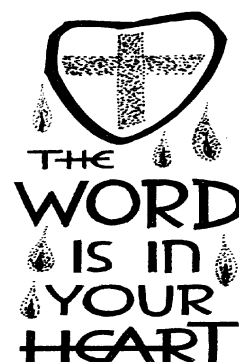
