PARISH MINISTRIES

1. **Communion Ministries.** There are three Communion Ministries; Ministers of Communion at Mass, Ministers of Communion to the Sick, and Communion Service Ministers. Ministers of Communion at Mass, we see each week helping to distribute Holy Communion. Ministers to the sick take Communion to the six different hostels for the aged and Nursing Homes in the Parish. Communion Service ministers conduct Communion Services on weekdays when there is no Mass. We always need people to help with communion to the sick so that the burden does not become too much for too few. cont....

PARISH MINISTRIES cont...

There is great satisfaction in this ministry. For both ministers at Mass and ministers to the sick, we need people on the rosters and people who may not be able to be on the roster but who can fill in when we need someone. We have eight Communion Service ministers but would be happy to have more volunteers.

2. **Musicians and Choir:** We have a very active music ministry here in the parish and we owe a great deal to our organists, guitarists and leaders of the music. This ministry becomes more demanding during Lent, Easter and Advent. We really need people to help lead the singing at each Mass; it can be difficult at times when there is no one to help lead the singing. The Choir also needs support and greater numbers—in all there would be no more than 12 practices a year. Step forward please!

WEEKDAY MASSES: There will be a 9.30am Mass on Monday, other days of the week there will be Communion Services, as Fr Frank will be at the National Priests Conference during the days.

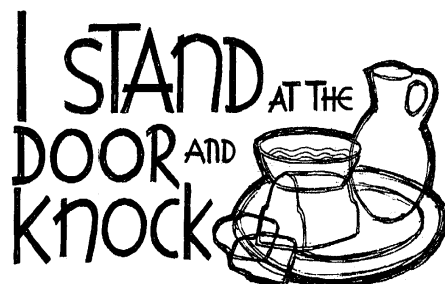
