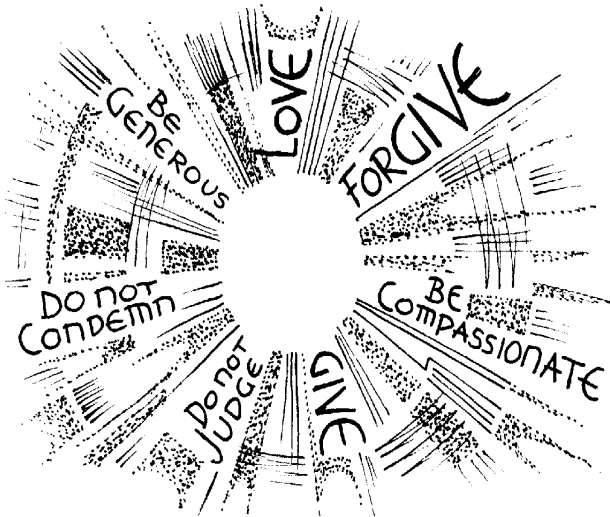
ST BEDE'S COLLEGE OPEN DAY

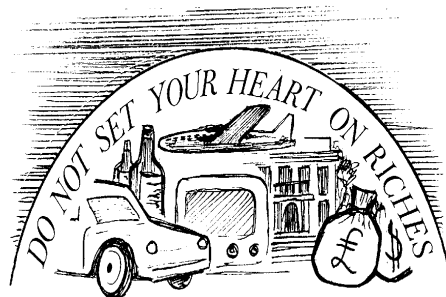
