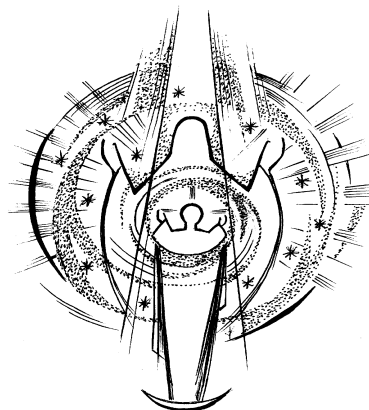
PARISH MINISTRIES

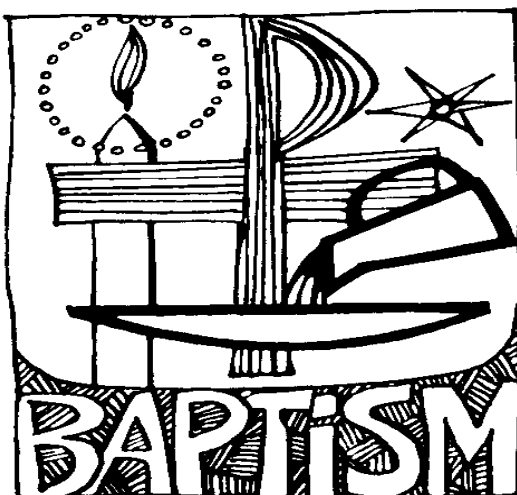

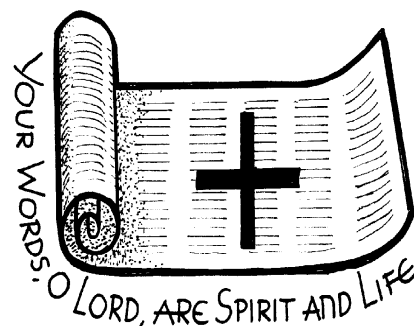
