Enemies begin to speak to one another, those estranged join hands in friendship, and nations seek to way of peace together.

Your Spirit is at work when understanding puts an end to strife, when hatred is quenched by mercy, and vengeance gives way to forgiveness."

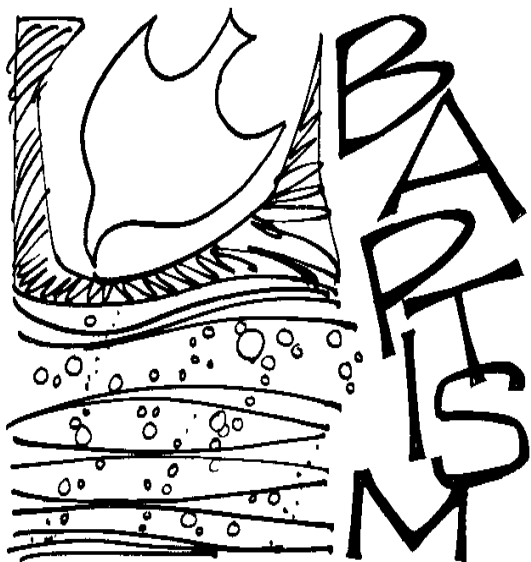
## **JEWISH-CATHOLIC RELATIONS :**
