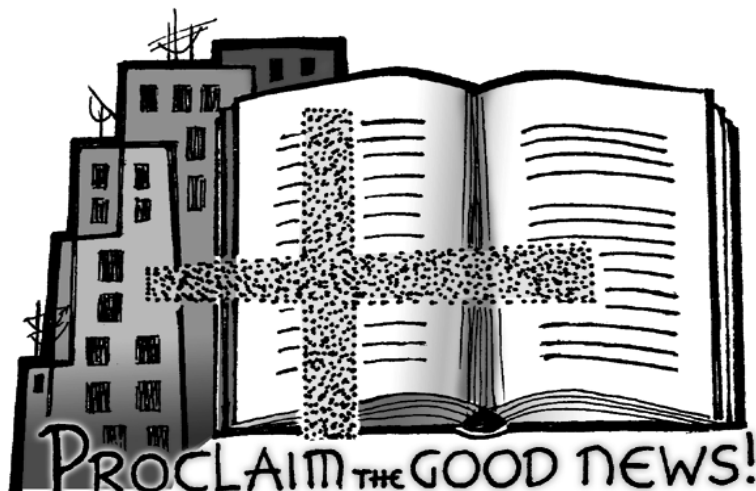

COMMUNION TO THE SICK:**

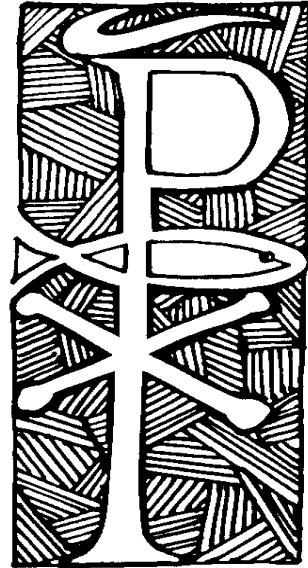
We are in need of another volunteer
