Sheets for Reflection and Prayer for the third week of Lent are available in the foyer after Mass.


### **LENTEN LECTURES :**

Every year we have two working bees to prepare the Church for Christmas and Easter.


**The Easter working bee will be on Tuesday April 11th at 2pm.**


