We have produced a report which provides a summary of the priorities, activities and achievements of the Group in 2016.

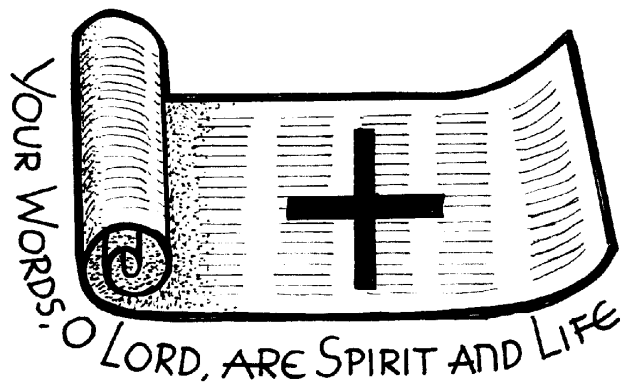
The report is available at all Masses this weekend.

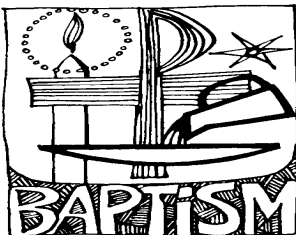
