There will be a Soup and Sweets lunch at All Soul's Anglican Church next Sunday at 12 noon as an Ecumenical Pentecost Get-together.

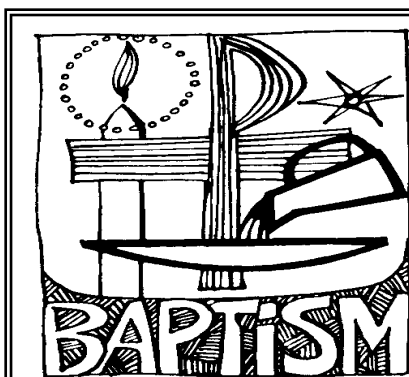

### **Recognition for First Peoples**

This weekend is the 50th Anniversary of the 1967 Referendum which changed the Constitution to include Aboriginal people in the national census. While this was a watershed moment in Australian history, the amendments made no mention whatsoever of the First Peoples (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people) and contained clauses which allowed discrimination on the basis of race. In 2010, the Federal Government made a commitment to hold a referendum to remedy these problems. Consultations have been taking place across Australia, and representatives of the First Peoples have been meeting at Uluru over the past few days to make recommendations about these changes.

We pray for a just resolution to this significant issue.
