

THROUGHOUT Easter's fifty days the paschal candle stands, prominent and lofty, in the middle of the Eucharistic hall. As the centre pole of the new creation, the candle is Christ, the Alpha and Omega of all times and ages.

Five wax nails are inserted into the candle to signify the wounds that Jesus received in his hands, feet and side when he was crucified.

"By his holy and glorious wounds, may Christ our Lord guard and keep us." These wounds do not vanish. They remain with Jesus who repeatedly shows them to his disciples. They are offered as marks of recognition: "Look at my hands and my feet; it is really I." (Luke 24:39).

Lit as the first act of the community's paschal watch, this mighty pillar of light remains in place for the duration of the fifty days enabling the faithful to see, to recognize, to find their way.

It is the light of Christ revealing the love of the Father, and the power of the Spirit in whom humanity is born from above.


