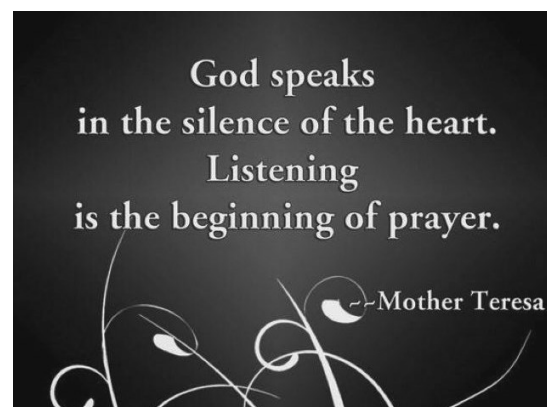

FEAST OF OUR LADY: There are two feasts of Our Lady this week. On Monday, we have the new feast of 'Mary, Mother of the Church' (the day after Pentecost Sunday each year) and on Thursday we have the feast of 'Our Lady, Help of Christians' - the title under which Our Lady is called patroness of Australia



PLENARY COUNCIL:

In 2020 there will be a Plenary Council of the whole Australian Church to take account of the Church's situation today and to look to the future.

Today, Pentecost Sunday has been chosen as the day to launch the Plenary Council. Representatives for each diocese have been appointed to begin the process, along with a facilitating team led by Fr Noel Connolly, a Columban Father. We pray that this initiative may indeed 'bite the bullet'.
