THE GLORIA

The Gloria, also known as the "greater doxology", is an inheritance from the treasury of early Christian hymns modelled upon the psalms and canticles of the Bible. First found in Greek and Syrian sources, this song of praise was used as an Easter hymn of dawn and gradually found a place at the conclusion of morning prayer in the east. It entered the west by way of Gaul and by the beginning of the sixth century was already incorporated into the Roman Mass, although only when the bishop presided on Sundays and feasts of the martyrs. The hymn was used by priests only at the Easter Vigil. By the eleventh century it was sung at all Masses on Sundays and festive occasions.
