There are clipboards in the foyer this morning for you to sign up and show your interest. There will be groups at various times during those weeks.

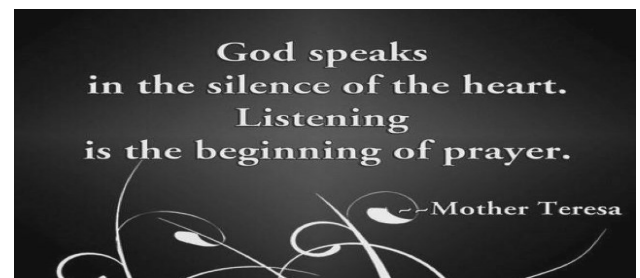
