#### FR FRANK BACK FROM EUROPE

Well I'm back home after being in Europe. There were highlights of course and much of the repetition of the usual things I do. I had a successful time in the library at Leuven, finding everything I was looking for—not always the case.

I have great esteem and affection for St Ireneus of Lyon and have never been able to get into the Church where he is buried; but this year I was able to by sheer chance and was able to see where he was buried and visit the old (underground) part of Lyon. Lyon is the second oldest Christian community in Western Europe that we know of. It goes back to about 150AD.

Fr Kevin and I had a splash-out meal (French) in a place called Bray near Windsor in England. Very Good Indeed. *Cont'd....*

I kept up visiting new Churches in Europe: Two in Paris which I had been to before and one in Rome—both very new and imaginative. Sign of the future! I have photographs of these.

I was consistently struck by two things: (1) the incredible influence of Pope Francis giving new life to the Church—and fearful reaction to him. (2) Everywhere I went I found people praying—quietly, peacefully, faithfully.

I had time with 3 sets of our own parishioners: Paul and Helen Commins in Bologna, Camilla Russell and her husband Mario Casari in Rome, and Martin and Katarina Gono, who were parishioners 13 years ago and then returned to Slovakia. They came to Rome to visit me.
