

## Pope Francis has declared 8<sup>th</sup> February to be the World Day of Prayer Reflection and Action against Human Trafficking for the Universal Church.

He chose this day because it is the feast day of St Josephine Bakhita, patron saint of Sudan and of Trafficked People.

St. Josephine Bakhita was kidnapped as a child from Africa and sold into slavery in the Sudan and in Italy before being freed and becoming a Canossian Sister. You are encouraged by the ACRATH (Australian Catholic Religious Against Trafficking in Humans).

A vigil Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Peter A. Comensoli at 7.30pm on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2019 in St. Patrick's Cathedral.
