MARRIED DEACONS:

In discussion with parishioners in the course of the last week, it came up that several were not aware that we have married deacons in the Archdiocese of Melbourne.

There has been a formation program for married deacons over the last ten years, some 20 to 30 deacons have been ordained. The agreement of the deacon's spouse is required. The formation requires both personal formation and theological formation normally at B.Theol level.

Deacons can celebrate baptisms, marriages and funerals not involving the Mass. They can also preach and be involved in pastoral work.
