

ASH WEDNESDAY

Back to Old Testament times, Ashes - along with dressing in sackcloth - were a sign of repentance. We no longer use the sackcloth, but we do Ashes of course.

Each Ash Wednesday, we are marked on the forehead with Ashes in the form of a cross. It is a sign that we are beginning our season of self-examination, of recognition of the good in us and of our capacity to do ill. Even more is this a season for turning to God as the source of our life and the source of all goodness.

Ashes: We get them when something is destroyed by fire. It is as if we drive the life out of things when we burn them.....we say we reduce things to ashes. By being marked with ashes, we acknowledge that without God, we are like ashes! It is God who gives us life, who makes us as his beloved children. Without Him, we are like ashes. We do this at the beginning of the season that culminates at Easter where we celebrate the life God will give us in the future.
