FASTING

Lent is a time of fasting. We fast (usually from food) as means of gaining greater strength and bringing order into our lives. We cannot have everything we want. If we just keep giving into what we want or desire, we will superficially overlook things which are of greater value than what we 'want'. We often have to be able to deny ourselves things for a greater good as parents do constantly for the sake of their children. Fasting is a means of gaining strength over our wants and desires; it is a means of learning to discern what really matters in our life. Fasting is a way in which we take the words of Jesus seriously, that we do not live on bread alone but only every word that comes from the mouth of God. Fasting is a part of turning minds and hearts to greater attention to God.
