
A hint for those who have bought a copy: It can be a good idea to start reading the book at chapter 2. That is where the real point of the book begins.

St Vincent de Paul Winter Appeal:

At each Mass this weekend a member of SVDP Sandringham Conference will speak briefly on Conference activities and the forthcoming winter appeal. We appreciate your past generosity which has enabled our volunteers to provide much needed and appreciated assistance to those in need in our area.
