

PROGRESS OF PLENARY COUNCIL:

The Parish Leadership Group last Monday night was updated on the progress of the Plenary Council by Judy Lamb, who has attended several input sessions on the developments towards the Plenary Council.

The present period—since our first discussion groups—have been one of gathering and sorting out the many submissions that have been received.

This has been sorted into six themes:

- (1) Missionary and evangelizing
- (2) Inclusive, participatory and synodal
- (3) Prayerful and eucharistic
- (4) Humble, healing and merciful
- (5) A joyful hope-filled and serving community
- (6) Open to conversation, renewal and reform.

The next lot of discussions on the above themes will take place here in the Parish in late February and early March 2020.

There are sheets available in the foyer delineating further these six themes.

APPEAL for CLEANING PRODUCTS

Many thanks to all those who so generously supported the appeal for cleaning products to assist asylum seekers and to those who made cash donations. In recent months, the Australian Government has cut all payments to many asylum seekers. Those who are unable to find work have no means of support and the situation for many of them is desperate. Through the Brigidine Asylum Seeker Project, these kitchen, bathroom and laundry products will be distributed to those most in need. The appeal closes this weekend, 15 September, but if you wish to bring something next week, we will ensure it is delivered with the other goods. Once again, the generosity of the parish has been outstanding.
