PLENARY COUNCIL GROUPS: Discernment:

The upcoming groups for the Plenary Council are about <u>discernment</u>. There has been an abundance of feed-in to the organizing committee. It is now time for groups all over the country to discern these issues. Discernment involves the use of some Scripture passages, time of quiet, listening and responding. It is not a time for arguing, but for listening and allowing the Spirit to move us and move among us. These meetings will be led by members of the Parish Leadership Group.

The meetings will be on Wednesday February 19th at 1pm and on Thursday February 21st at 7pm.

If numbers require it, we will divide into smaller groups at each of these times.

<u>Please take part in these groups</u>: your feed-in and discernment is important. Of the six thematic areas various groups all over the country will consider, ours is the following (No.5):

A joyful, hope-filled and serving community

There was a yearning for the Church to be a sign of God's kingdom for all people in Australia—to be able to see the Catholic Church in action, and to recognise Jesus. There was an expression of faith-filled hope in the capacity of the Catholic community to celebrate together, to show what it is to be a follower of Christ and to be loved unconditionally by God. There was a call to contemplate the Gospel call to be a servant Church for the good of all people in Australia—particularly for refugees and asylum seekers and other people who are vulnerable or at risk. Many responses called for greater sharing of the story of the good works done by so many people and organisations of the Church. Some responses expressed a hunger for strong witness of faith, especially by priests, young people and female leaders in parish and school ministries.
