PROJECTOR & SCREEN:

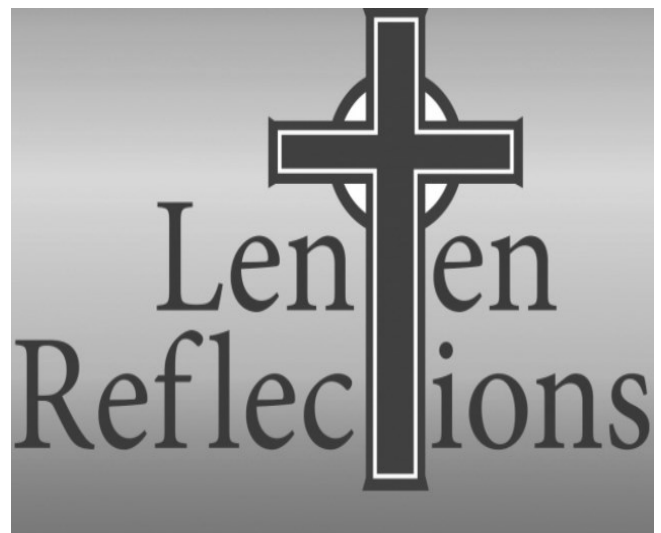
We have a process afoot to look at replacing our present projector as we are aware that the print on the screen does not stand out sufficiently.

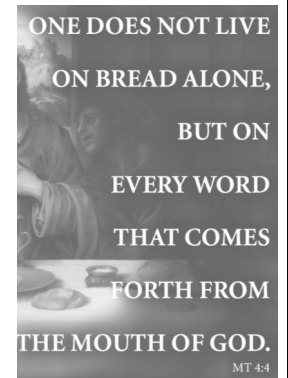
